

Spring Flower Library Lesson (1st) April 20th – 27th

1. Ask: What are some types of flowers?
Why are flowers and plants important?
Discuss your child's answers. (It doesn't have to be formal just a conversation.)
2. Go to the link:

Click Pre- K to K
Scroll down to the books: Planting a Rainbow and It Could Still Be a Flower
4. Read the books together or let your child follow along with the read aloud.
5. Click on the link **Puzzlers** on the right hand side of the site to complete the tasks after the books are read. (Good time to point out that the first story Plant a Rainbow is fiction. (It's just a made up story about planting flowers. The book It Could Still Be a Flower is non-fiction because the book features real facts about flowers and their parts.)
6. Kids can click the Explore the Web to get more information about flowers and plants.
The link is safe for kiddos.
