Spring Flower Library Lesson (1st) April 20th – 27th

- Ask: What are some types of flowers? Why are flowers and plants important? Discuss your child's answers. (It doesn't have to be formal just a conversation.)
- 2. Go to the link:

- 4. Read the books together or let your child follow along with the read aloud.
- 5. Click on the link <u>Puzzlers</u> on the right hand side of the site to complete the tasks after the books are read. (Good time to point out that the first story Plant a Rainbow is fiction. (It's just a made up story about planting flowers. The book It Could Still Be a Flower is non-fiction because the book features real facts about flowers and their parts.)
- 6. Kids can click the Explore the Web to get more information about flowers and plants. <u>The link is safe for kiddos.</u>
- 7. Lesson over. Hope you learned more about flowers than you already knew!
- 8. Miss you. Mr. Flanegan
